Format:

Dressage test followed by Stadium Jumping Test

First attempt of dressage and jumping at level count for placings, riders can enter multiple divisions.
Single tests at any level may be entered for schooling purposes, but do not count toward placing.

Dressage tests:

All levels will do Explore Eventing Test 1
**Intro may choose to trot in place of canter

Jumping heights:

Intro to Eventing – 6" (poles only)
Starter – 22"
Pre-Entry – 2'5"
Entry – 2'9"
Pre-Training – 3'0"

Rules for the Combined Test

- A maximum of 3 jumping rounds can be entered per horse, per day. Horses may compete in same division with more than 1 rider.
- NO post entries and NO additional schooling on show day.
- Mandatory tack check before dressage is for educational and safety purposes. It will be contact free, please refer to Rules of Equestrian Canada Section D
- First full test (dressage AND jumping) at one level will count for placing.
- A full test (dressage AND jumping) at different level will also count for placing.
- Second round at same level or partial tests (one phase only) will not count toward placings

Dress Code

Breeches (light colour preferred), collared shirt, boot with heel appropriate for riding, safety vest recommended for stadium jumping, helmet, pinny/number holder required (may be purchased via show office). Show jackets not required in eventing at these levels. Arm band not required.

Scoring

In Eventing (combined tests included), the lowest final score wins!

Dressage – test is scored as percentage, then subtracted from 100 to give eventing penalty point score.

Example: a dressage test scored at 65.0% will be 35.0pp (penalty points), score to be carried to jumping

Stadium Jumping

Knocking down an obstacle – 4 Penalties

1st Refusal, run-out or circle – 4 Penalties

2nd Refusal, run-out or circle – 8 Penalties

3rd Refusal, run-out or circle on course – Elimination

**Time Faults – 0.4 Penalties/second over the posted time allowed

- **EE rule modification: to reward safe, thoughtful riding at these low levels: rounds will NOT be timed and therefore will not receive time faults in stadium at this event

Cause for Elimination

Fall of Competitor and/or Horse anywhere on the course – rider may NOT remount.

In cases of rule misunderstandings, riders may be allowed to continue to participate at the discretion of the ground jury, but in such cases will be eliminated from placings.

Other causes for elimination are as per Rules of Equestrian Canada Section D and/or at the discretion of the ground jury.

Biosecurity Measures

Proof of vaccinations is not required for horses (or humans). Horse owners are encouraged to have horses vaccinated for Equine Influenza, EHV, and strangles – along with any other vaccinations recommended by their veterinarian for their area. Horses from separate herds/stables should not directly interact. Please avoid sharing water buckets, feed buckets, and grooming equipment when possible. Please bring own water for horses and humans.
